- 2. Is there a Student Activity Fee (SAF) with the application process? What does the SAF cover?

\*Funds are used to upgrade school facilities and classroom materials which benefit the entire school

- Students applying to the **Holy Cross High Performer Athlete Program** will be required to pay an application fee of \$50
- Students applying to the Holy Cross Catholic Academy Pre-IB Programme will be required to pay an application fee of \$25

**PLEASE NOTE:** There will be a \$30.00 Administration Fee for students withdrawing their registration

- 5. I have an IEP (Individual Education Plan); do I still have one in high school?
  - YES, it is part of your transition plan to secondary school. Accommodations are available for students who require them. Your Special Education Teacher will be happy to help you.
- 6. What can I do to help support my child's learning from home?
  - Remind your child to check their teacher's Virtual Learning Environment (VLE), such as D2L or Google Classroom and School Email Account (YCDSBK12 account) for course information
  - Encourage your child to use an organizational tool for course work and to help manage their time appropriately to ensure classwork responsibilities are met
  - Support your child in advocating for themselves such as speaking to their teacher for clarification and/or extra help, as needed

## 7. Are there additional resources available to help make the transition from Grade 8 to Grade 9?

- Kick Start Program: The **Kickstart Summer Program** is a great way for in-coming Holy Cross Academy's Grade 9 students to address both challenges and opportunities. It helps to facilitate a soft-landing into secondary and their new home for the next four years.
- The **Kickstart Summer Program** will focus on helping current Grade 8 students develop the foundational literacy and numeracy skills for a successful transition into high school.
- In addition to these skills, the program will also focus on student well-being, which could include pathways planning, mindfulness, and time and stress management techniques and will include daily physical activity.
- Students in the Kickstart Summer Program at Holy Cross Catholic Academy will earn their first High School credit in HIF1O1 – Individual and Family Living (Open) Grade 9. This course will count as one (1) high school credit that students will use towards graduation.

### 8. Are there opportunities for parents to get involved?

- Holy Cross Catholic Academy has a strong Catholic School Council who welcome parent involvement and input: <u>Catholic School Council</u>
- Attend Parent-Teacher Interview Night, offered once per semester to meet your child's teachers, to discuss your child's progress and next steps

### 9. Can I change course types?

• YES, you can change course types when moving from Grade 9 to Grade 10. This can only be done in the subjects of English and Science. You can move to academic from applied depending on achievement.

- Math can also be changed, however, a transfer course is required to be completed in Summer School. This is also dependent on achievement and teacher recommendation.
