






Student Instructions:

Important Reminders To Read Before Beginning	
If you are a YCDSB student taking YCDSB eLearn	Please note that you will not receive a mark for your eLearn course on your homeschool report card unless your eLearn teacher is from your home school. Your eLearn mark is generated on a separate YCDSB report card.
If you are YCDSB student taking an eLearn course with another school board	Please ask your course teacher how to access your midterm and final report card as these instructions do not apply to you.
If you are a non-YCDSB student taking a YCDSB eLearn course	Please follow the instructions below, however be sure to use your @ycdsbk12.ca account information to sign in.
